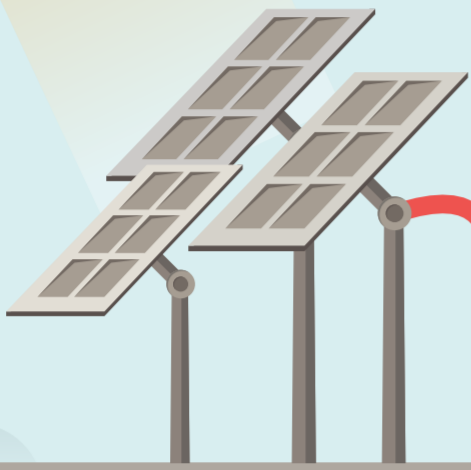


# IT IS EASY BEING GREEN

From solar panels to electric car charging stations, UW Medicine hospitals are going green top to bottom.



Harborview's **solar panels** are expected to generate 109,000 kilowatt hours of electricity a year—enough to brew 1.3 million pots of coffee.



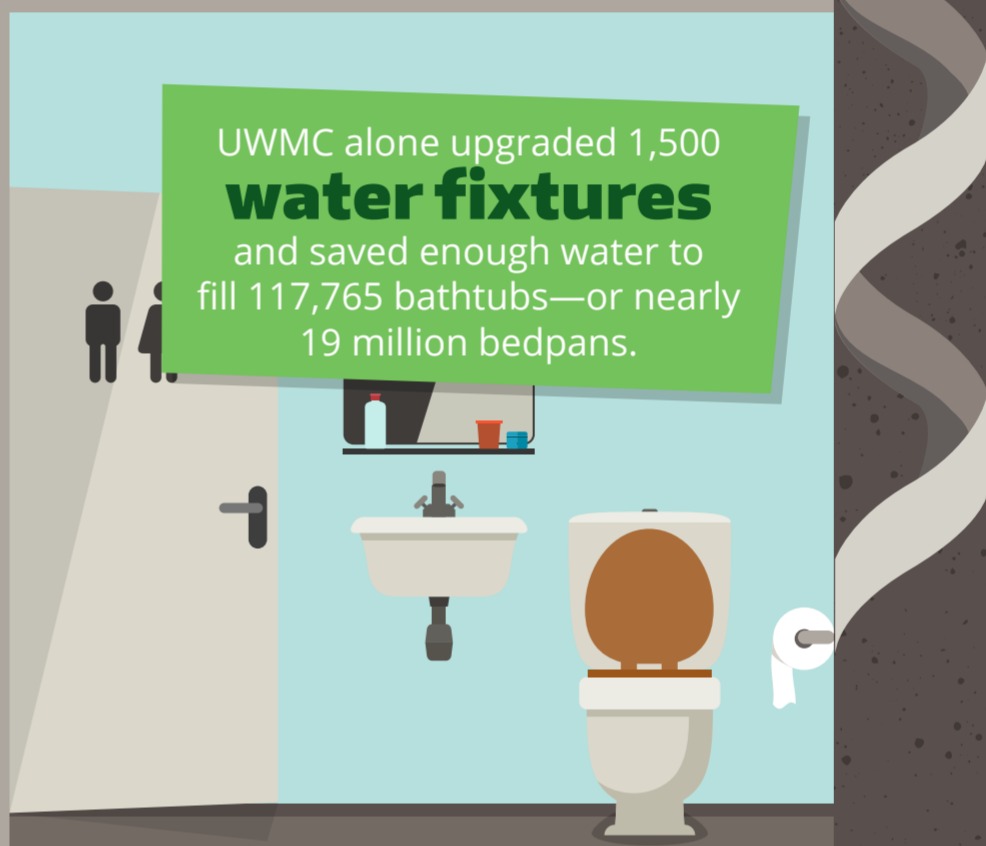
Our toilet paper and paper towels are made from 1,000 tons of our own **shredded and recycled** confidential documents.



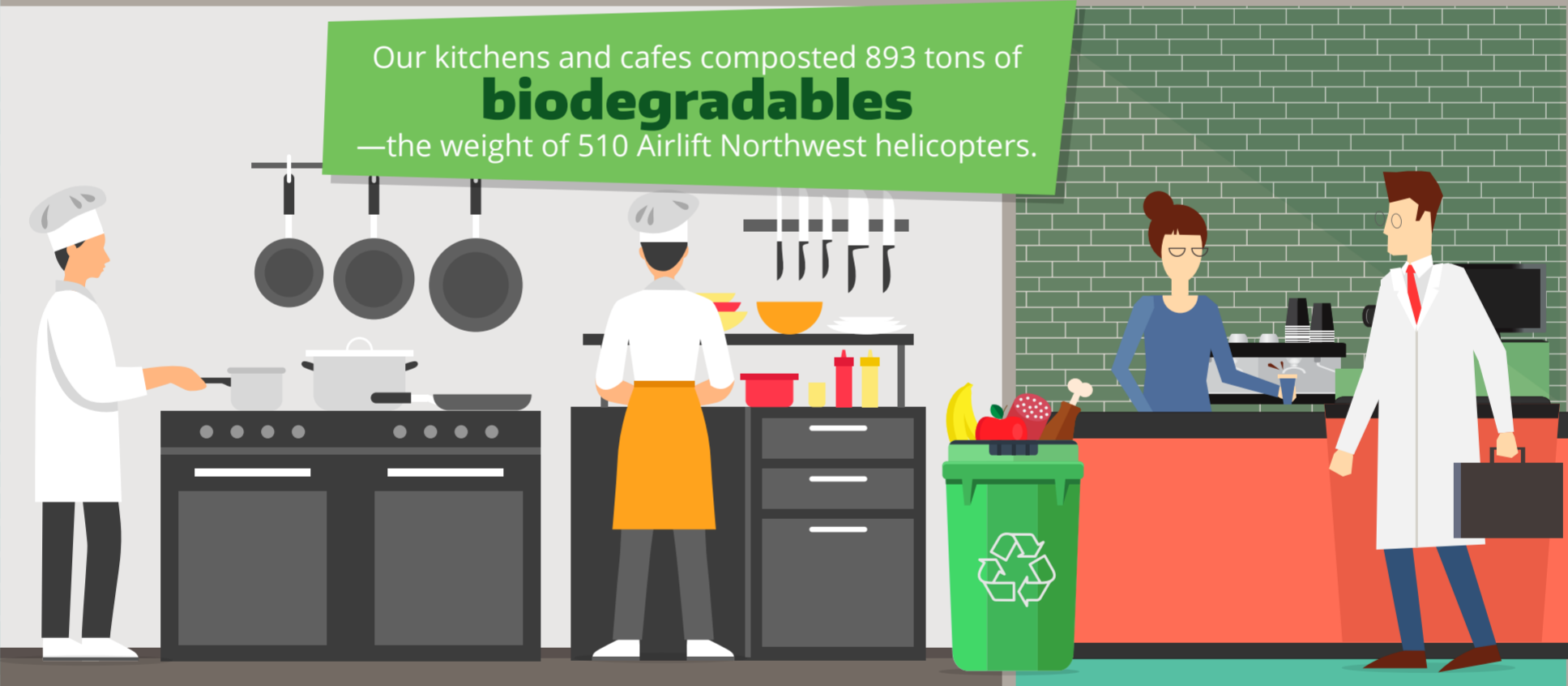
We swapped more than 7,000 inefficient **lightbulbs** for LEDs, and the energy savings could light 711,000 offices from sunup to sundown.



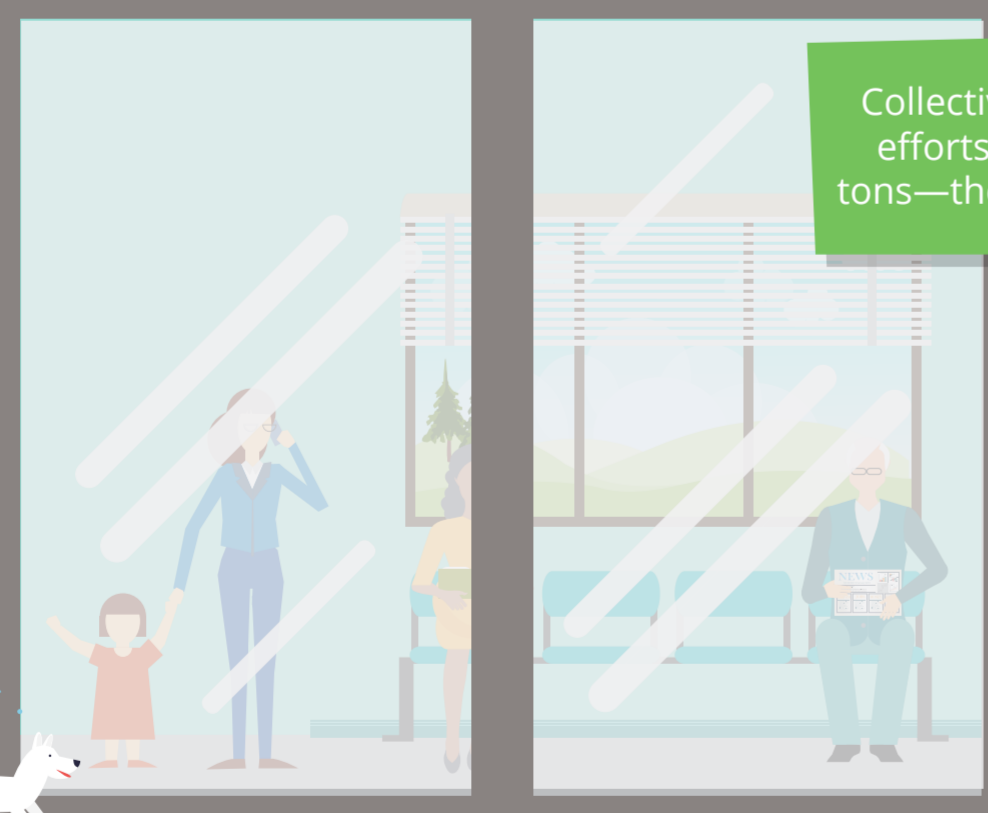
UWMC alone upgraded 1,500 **water fixtures** and saved enough water to fill 117,765 bathtubs—or nearly 19 million bedpans.



Our kitchens and cafes composted 893 tons of **biodegradables**—the weight of 510 AirLift Northwest helicopters.



Collectively, our **recycling** efforts tipped the scales at 2,168 tons—the weight of 310 ambulances.
